HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT



- encourage and enable staff to identify and report hazards so that we can all contribute towards improving safety
- ensure the safe handling, storage and use of substances
- provide adequate first aid facilities, materials and trained personnel to deal with injuries and medical emergencies
- ensure that robust procedures are in place at all locations for dealing with fire emergencies and other significant incidents
- provide and maintain safe premises, plant and equipment and have healthy working conditions
- engage contractors who are able to effectively demonstrate their due diligence with regard to health and safety matters
- provide adequate resources to control health and safety risks arising from our work activities including providing PPE where required
- provide adequate training to ensure all employees are competent to do their work
- provide information, instruction and supervision for employees
- regularly monitor performance and revise policies and procedures to facilitate a programme of continuous improvement.
